ESL/HSE/SNAP Venture & CLIP Program

During April, students in the Winter/Spring 2024 semester of Stredesto Continuing Success ESL/FoodHandlersCertificateTrainingProgram completed the second phase of their credential testing:14 of the 16 eligible candidatespassed the Department of Health and Mental HygieneFoodProtection exam, and additional program participants are scheduled to test in the near future.

The Kingsborough English Language Institute's intensive full time academic ESTO program recently commenced its Spring semester, along with the School Equivalency HSE 70 and the Alternative HSE reparation (AHSEP) rogram, Diploma Now. This full time HSE preparation program focuses core content areas, such as math, science, social studies, and ELA, and is developed for explication of the school youth aged 17 1/2 and 20. Diploma Now vides an alternative pathway to attaining the high school chips.
