

Changes to the Community Health A.S. Degree

The attached revision to the Community Health curriculum follows the Community Health Study Report, the outside evaluator, and the Community Health retreat recommended by the college administrators, and faculty members for their advice and assistance.

1. Require (COH 0100) an opportunity to a four year major to complete Critical Issues in Community Health (COH 01300). This change will provide all majors core Community Health competencies needed for transition to the workplace.
2. Update the four year Health Major to H 02000. In order to enhance course transferability to other Community Health Interventions".
3. Allow student courses. One of the three credit Kingsborough computer literacy requirement from CP 01100 to BA 0600 or TEC 02500.
4. When possible, recommend a choice of Health Education courses. This change was recommended by the outside evaluator.
5. Change the requirement for MAT 0000 in Mathematics. Instead of requiring MAT 0070, the Community Health program will accept any 3- or 4-credit course in Mathematics.
6. Change the credit requirement for Aging (BIO 0300) in Biological Sciences. Students will complete one 3-credit laboratory course in biological sciences, either Human Genetics (BIO 0300) or Biology of the Cell (BIO 0300).
7. Add PSY 2000 to the Community Health curriculum. This change was recommended at the retreat with the four year colleges.
8. Add a concentration, Abuse Counseling, which makes students eligible for New York State certification in entry-level positions in the workplace.
9. Increase the credit requirement from 6 credits to 9 credits to maintain the A.S. degree.
