		start of the semester.

NONCOURSE FLAGS are indicators that a student is not behaving well in or out of the classroom such as academic integrity.

COURSE KUDCan be raised when a student exceeds course expectations.

NONCOURSE KUDCan be raised when a student gets off academic probation, has shown outstandingacademic performance, or any positive student behavior.

TODOSare types of actions that students are encouraged to take (ex. register for class, pick up IDCard, contact an individual for questions/support, etc.). Students will receive an email with instructions for the suggested action when a ToDo is raised.

REFERRALS instructors, advisors, and staff can refer students to various offices and services across campus. These offices and services are called the provider. Students will receive an email whethe referral is raised.
