

To file a complaint with the appropriate campus authority if they so choose.

To make a formal complaint at the campus as the first step in the disciplinary process.

To have the same opportunity as the respondent(s) to participate in the disciplinary process.

To report incidents of sexual harassment or sexual violence that they witness or are aware of to the appropriate campus authority if they so choose.

To have the same opportunity as the respondent(s) to participate in the disciplinary process, including the right to be heard, to present evidence, to be represented by an advisor, and to appeal the outcome of the disciplinary process.
