Articulation Agreement

For admission to the ECAE department of Brooklyn College, KCC graduates must demonstrate proficiency in 2 required English courses, with a minimum grade of C in both classes.

For admission to the ECAE department of Brooklyn College, KCC graduates must have up-to-date immunizations.

For admission to the ECAE department of Brooklyn College, KCC graduates must be finger printed and cleared.

For admission to the ECAE department of Brooklyn College, KCC graduates must register for Math 1021 and/or Math 1010 during the first semester at Brooklyn College and pass the Math Proficiency Exam. Math 900 can be used to lieu of Math 1021 only if students pass the proficiency exam.

Graduates of the A.S. degree program who have not completed at least 6 credits of foreign language study (or established and equivalent proficiency) may be asked to complete 6 credits of foreign
