This Agreement is between St. John's University New York ("St. John's" or "the University"), an institution of higher education formed and existing under the New York Education Law, and Kingsborough Community College formed and existing under the State of

WHEREAS, Kingsborough Community College desires to provide for the preferential admission of well-qualified Kingsborough Community College students to St. John's University, and

WHEREAS, in support of its academic mission, St. John's University desires to accept as

WHEREAS, the successful implementation of Kingsborough Community College students to the University, the successful implementation of the Agreement depends upon communication of its contents to all involved participants and assumption of responsibility by both institutions for the communication

NOW THEREFORE, Kingsborough Community College and St. John's University agree as follows for the mutual covenants contained in this agreement and for other good and valuable consideration, the receipt and adequacy of which are hereby acknowledged:

General Terms

This Agreement shall automatically renew on an annual basis. This Agreement will be reviewed every year and may be terminated or amended as provided for in Article II. If either party gives written notice, however, all students currently enrolled in the program at Kingsborough Community College will be permitted to complete their degree and transfer to St. John's University before final phase out of this Agreement occurs.

Each School must suppress any information or statements about the program, whether published only in one School's materials (including admissions information, student bulletins, course guides, etc.) or otherwise.

Each party warrants that it shall not discriminate on the basis of race, color, national or ethnic origin, sex, marital status, disability or any other protected class in

provide Kingsborough Community College to remedy any curricular or non-curricular problems affecting the ease of transfer.

provide Kingsborough Community College with data including number of Kingsborough Community College applicants to SUNY, number of accepted students and where possible reasons why students have declined admission.

KINGSBOROUGH COMMUNITY COLLEGE will:

publicize this Agreement to students, faculty and professional staff in campus presentations.

have advisors inform interested students of this opportunity.

obtain consent from its students in order to provide a list of graduates upon request.

organize a "St. John's Day" for students to meet with advisors on the Kingsborough Community College campus.

assure that brochures and other printed materials are distributed to its transfer office, advisement center and academic departments.


advertise any special programs or events the University is offering on Kingsborough Community College's campus.

Transfer Guidelines

Attached as Exhibit A are the guidelines governing the transfer of credits from Kingsborough Community College to the University (the "Transfer Guidelines"). The University and Kingsborough Community College also will meet from time to time to identify any difficulties in implementing the Transfer Guidelines with particular attention to courses and classes (i.e. Kingsborough Community College classes for which students will receive University credits). The University reserves the right in its academic discretion to modify or amend programs as it would with its four-year students whenever it deems appropriate.


