ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

BETWEEN

State University

College of Technology at Delhi

And

Kingsborough Community College

The State University College of Technology at Delhi agrees to articulate with Kingsborough Community College by providing opportunities for appropriately qualified students to complete the Bachelor of Science in Nursing. Students who have completed articulation in this program will finish their education in a process that will allow them to continue their studies at the State University College of Technology at Delhi, completing all requirements for a corresponding Bachelor of Science in Nursing.

While admission to the State University College of Technology at Delhi is competitive, students satisfying the following requirements will be accepted:

1. Current RN license.
2. Official transcripts from all schools attended are required.
3. Minimum of 60 semester hours from an associate degree nursing program with nursing coursework grades of C+ or better, and liberal arts and science courses of C or better. Science courses include anatomy and physiology I & II, microbiology, English, psychology and statistics* (*while a PSYC/Research Methods course may transfer into the program and meet the pre-requisite requirements for graduation).
4. Minimum of 20 credit hours of upper division credits, with a minimum GPA of 2.0 or higher.

**Above requirements are subject to change*

This articulation is based on the following inter-institutional agreements:

That the State University College of Technology at Delhi will provide financial aid support to matriculated students that qualify for financial aid. The school code is 002857. Contact the SUNY Delhi Financial Aid Office at financialaid@delhi.edu for additional information. Interested students must submit an application for admission, along with college transcripts as required by the Enrollment Services Office at the State University College of Technology at Delhi.


2. SUNY Delhi advisors will assume responsibility for advising students who are covered by this agreement. SUNY Delhi curriculum fact sheets will be used as the mechanism for communicating degree requirements to students. Fact sheets will be reviewed annually and appropriate revisions to guide sheets will be made as each institution adds, deletes, or changes course offerings.

3. The Associate Dean, School of Nursing at the State University College of Technology at Delhi and The Chairperson at Kingsborough Community College will be designated as contact persons and coordinators of this agreement.


TERMINATION AGREEMENT

Notification shall be given in writing at least six (6) months prior to the proposed date of termination.


The State University College of Technology at Delhi will supply Kingsborough Community College with promotional and informational literature, which will be used to assist students, faculty, and staff.


